Get Out to Vote: Residents are reminded that the General Election will be held on November 5, with Dover polls open 7 am to 7 pm. Whittier Falls is in Ward 5 and the polling place is the Dover Middle School located at 16 Daley Drive. Don't forget to vote and make your voice heard! Snow, Snow, Snooooo!!! It's only a matter of time before winter hits Whittier Falls. And Addison Place Be prepared and get those winter shovels out. **Residents are reminded that they are responsible to shovel out their own walkways (including around the buks heads) and parking spaces.** Also, don't forget to register your vehicle(s) with the Office and get a parking decal so your vehicle can be identified. Finally, sign up for winter parking ban notifications— so when the big winter storms come and prevents parking on the city streets, (ALL Whittier Falls streets are city-owned and part of the winter bans), you won't get a ticket or towed.

HOW TO RECEIVE WINTER PARKING BAN NOTIFICATIONS:

Notifications of parking bans are posted on Channel 22, the city's website, social media, and distributed to local news media. Sign up for text alerts via the City of Dover's emergency notification system, CodeRED, by texting "DoverNH" to 99411. Please note that cellular phone carrier and/or text message fees may apply. Text alerts are also available by creating an account and logging into to the City's emergency notification system, CodeRED. Once you've created a managed account, you can select the option for Parking Ban Notifications under additional notifications. Please note you'll need to provide a phone number capable of receiving text alerts. Depending on your cellular phone carrier and plan, fees may apply.
